**Duties:** Operate track switches; adjust various freight car components in order to couple cars; couple and uncouple cars; mount and dismount equipment with a base step height of eighteen (18) inches from the ground; climb on equipment to heights of up to twenty (20) feet in order to secure and release hand brakes; be capable of lifting up to eighty (80) lbs., without assistance, in order to replace knuckles on equipment; operate locomotives; perform minor AAR billable equipment repairs; perform maintenance on locomotives and other railroad-owned equipment; operate a two-way radio while riding on moving equipment; be capable of announcing clearly and concisely when speaking; follow instructions in a respectful and timely fashion when received; maintain and submit accurate, legible car movement and car repair records; be computer literate; be trainable for later advancement; be capable of working **safely** in all weather conditions and perform **any and all other duties that may be required** for the maintenance and continued operation of the railroad.

**Experience:** Prior freight railroad experience is **preferred, but not required.**

**Qualifications:** Candidates shall: Be required to pass an initial physical exam to include vision and hearing acuity tests as well as a drug/alcohol test; be subject to recurrent vision and hearing acuity tests as well as recurrent (and random) drug/alcohol testing as a condition of continued employment; have reliable transportation; have telephone access outside of the workplace; possess a valid driver's license and social security card; be a citizen of the United States.

**Training:** Shall be provided on-the-job. At the conclusion of the initial training period, the employee shall be required to pass compulsory examinations demonstrating his/her knowledge of the position and shall also be subject to recurrent training as a condition of continued employment.

**Probationary Period:** Applications for employment may be rejected **for any reason** within ninety (90) calendar days following an employee's first paid day of work.

**Advancement:** Opportunities for advancement are available for qualified candidates who have displayed leadership qualities.

**Hours:** Employees shall work up to 12-hour shifts on an as-needed basis.

**Salary:** Commensurate with experience.
