Greenville & Western Railway Company, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Western Carolina Railway Service Corporation, will be performing track maintenance and resurfacing of two rail-highway grade crossings during the week of June 15 to June 19, 2026.

Work Area 1 – G.W. Stevens Road (C-18-107)

In accordance with the attached Traffic Plan, Work Area 1 will be closed for approximately 98 hours, beginning 7:00 AM Monday, June 15, 2026, through 9:00 AM Friday, June 19, 2026. During this four-day road closure, **ALL TRAFFIC** will be required to detour around the area using G.W. Stevens Road (C-18-107, east of the closed railroad crossing), Beeks Road (C-18-25), and Belton Honea Path Highway (US 76 / US 178). Because G.W. Stevens Road (C-18-107) is not a commercial truck route, no separate Commercial Truck Traffic Detour Route has been planned, and the posted Detour Route is **NOT Commercial Truck Traffic capable**. **See attached Traffic Plan for G.W. Stevens Road.**

Work Area 2 – Simpson Road (S-04-205)

In accordance with the attached Traffic Plan, Work Area 2 will be closed for approximately 50 hours, beginning 7:00 AM Wednesday, June 17, 2026, through 9:00 AM Friday, June 19, 2026. During this two-day road closure, **ALL TRAFFIC** will be required to detour around the area using Simpson Road (S-04-205, east of the closed railroad crossing), Horace Bell Road (C-18-49), and Belton Honea Path Highway (US 76 / US 178). Because Simpson Road (S-04-205) is not a commercial truck route, no separate Commercial Truck Traffic Detour

Route has been planned, and the posted Detour Route is **NOT Commercial Truck Traffic capable**. **See attached Traffic Plan for Simpson Road**.

Work Area 1 and Work Area 2 Closure Times Will Overlap

Work Areas 1 and 2 will be simultaneously closed beginning the morning of Wednesday, June 17, 2026, and continuing through 9:00 AM Friday, June 19, 2026. This will result in both work areas being **simultaneously closed to traffic for approximately 50 hours**.

Caution is Urged

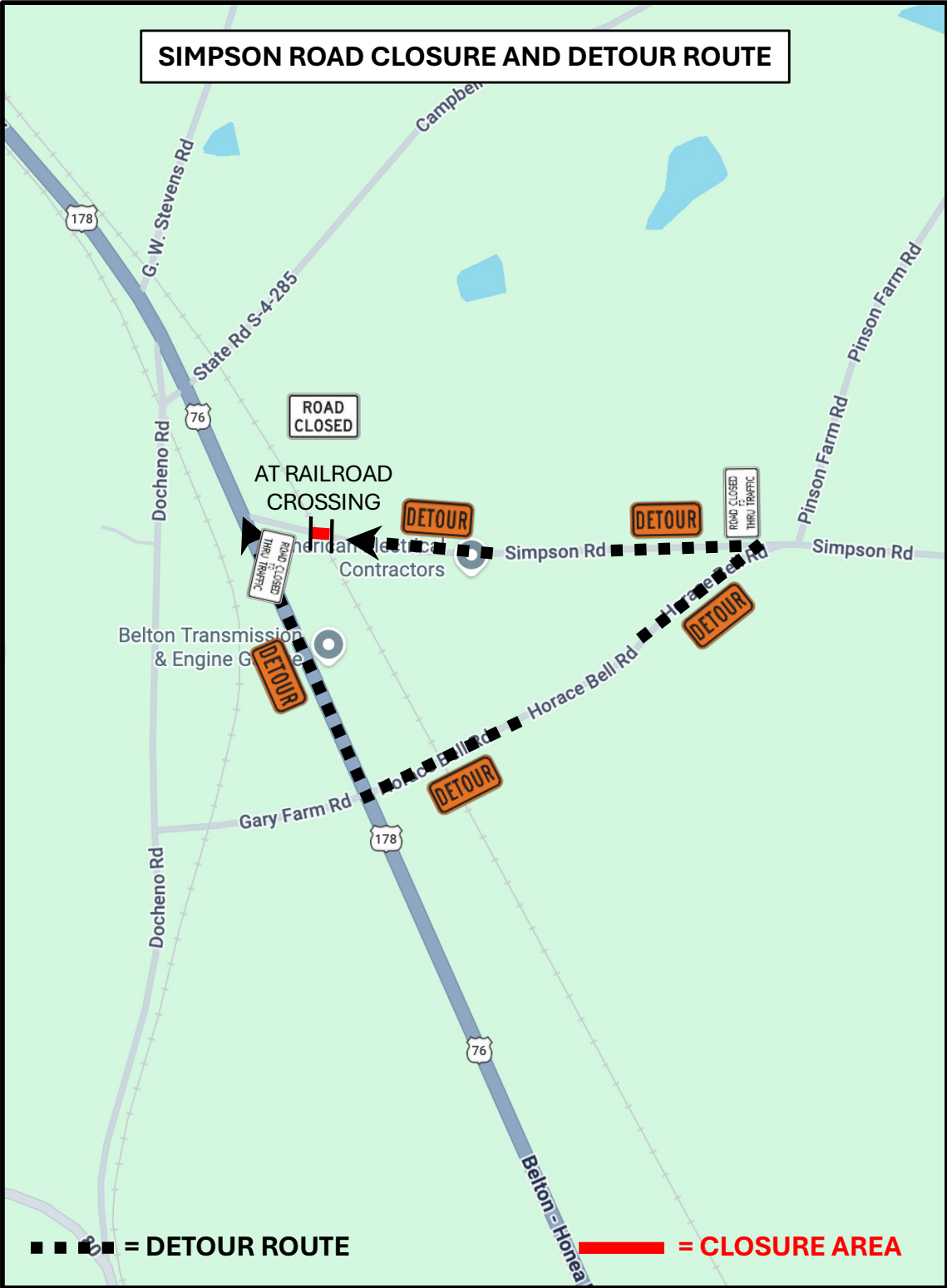
Motorist are urged to use caution when driving the posted detour routes and to be **watchful for men and equipment working in the vicinity of the closures**.
