Greenville & Western Railway Company, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Western Carolina Railway Service Corporation, will be performing track maintenance and resurfacing of the rail-highway grade crossing located on Beeks Road (C-18-25) during the week of July 28 to July 30, 2026.

Beeks Road (C-18-25)

In accordance with the attached Traffic Plan, Beeks Road (C-18-25) will be closed in the vicinity of the rail highway grade crossing near Belton Honea Path Highway (US 76 / US 178) for approximately 50 hours, beginning 7:00 AM Tuesday, July 28, 2026, through 9:00 AM Thursday, July 30, 2026. During this two-day road closure, **ALL TRAFFIC** will be required to detour around the area using Beeks Road (C-18-25, east of the closed railroad crossing), G.W. Stevens Road (C-18-107), and Belton Honea Path Highway (US 76 / US 178). Because Beeks Road (C-18-25) is not a commercial truck route, no separate Commercial Truck Traffic Detour Route has been planned, and the posted Detour Route is **NOT Commercial Truck Traffic capable**. **See attached Traffic Plan.**

Caution is Urged

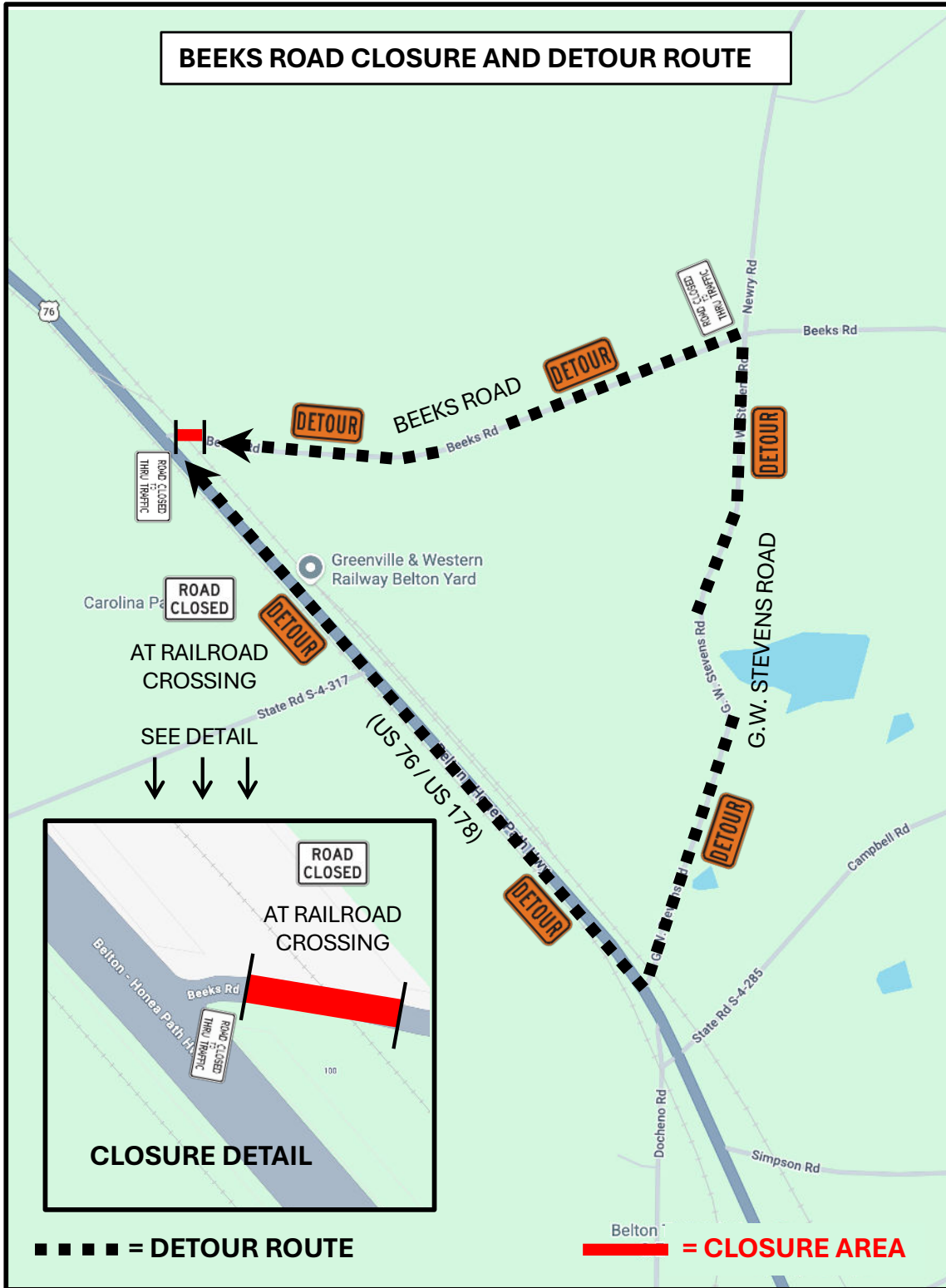
Motorist are urged to use caution when driving the posted detour routes and to be **watchful for men and equipment working in the vicinity of the closure.**
